Dear Pastor Corey And Callie Harbin BC,

It is almost 1 year since the Pandemic came and we praise our Almighty God for sustaining us throughout the year. We thank Him for all His grace, mercy and provision not only for our family but also for the ministry. Praise God also for His provision we were able to get our Working Permit Card for this year. We were able continue our CARE ministry - giving 10 kilos of rice monthly to 25 poor individuals/families particularly widows/widower and handicapped.

The first Sunday of January, we have evangelism for those who were not able to attend our Christmas Evangelism and praise God for 60 visitors and some professions of faith. We were able to saturate a new place called CHUP which is 25 minutes' drive away from our place. We distributed Gospel tracts and shared the Gospel to some people in the High school and Elementary school and also in their market and other stores.

Praise and glory to God, there were 4 baptisms on the 2nd week of February, 3 widow adults and 1 Youth. Praise God we were able to celebrate our 7th Church Anniversary with our members and some attendees together before the government stopped mass gatherings and countrywide GCQ. Praise God for the attendance and some professions of faith.

Its almost 3 months of this year that there are only few cases of Covid19 and zero death case here in Cambodia but so sad that at the end of February, some 29 Chinese foreigners arrived here who were tested positive and were in quarantine hotel escaped at night time, gave \$2,000 to the guard and went to different places. This started more local transmissions and rapid increase of cases again in the country. All schools were closed again and mass gatherings are stopped so it's been more than a month now that we don't have face to face services but we are having a worship service here at home and do it online so other members, friends and even loved ones can hear the Word of God.

Saturation in CHUP schools & market

Most provinces and cities are now lockdown due to the rapid increase of community transmission and now the government imposed a curfew from 8pm to 5am and travel ban from province to province to help control the transmission. 2 weeks ago, there was a family who tested positive in one of the villages where we are fetching kids which is just 15 minutes' walk from our village. His wife is a seller in the market where we always buy our goods. Praise God for His protection upon us.

Please continue to pray for us. Now the government is ordering a mandatory Covid19 Vaccination to all people here in the country especially the employees and foreigners. They have a new law here that those foreigners who will not obey rules connected to Covid19 will be fined and be deported immediately.
